ENDANGERED BY CLINT JENKINS

MCQ Fine Art is pleased to announce the first exhibition of works by photographer, Clint Jenkins. Large-scale photographs from the **Endangered** series will be on view at MCQ Fine Art from September 12 – October 18, 2013.

Clint Jenkins is an Australian born photographer, living and working in Las Vegas. From the age of twenty he spent a decade of his life travelling to over sixty countries, where he began his career in underwater photography.

It was a personal experience with a Pacific Green Turtle that prompted this visual investigation of these endangered creatures; expanding the series with the skulls of a variety of endangered animals, made available to him through several Natural History Museums. Jenkins has captured the essence of the fragility of these species, shedding light on the precariousness of their actual existence.

“My goal is to promote awareness of species which are threatened through capturing their beauty in an untraditional manner and accentuating the frailty of animals on the verge of extinction” says Jenkins.

A percentage of the proceeds from each purchase will be donated to the World Wildlife Fund.
